## Chief Information Security Officer (CISO)'s Training Program On Cyber Security (May 8-12, 2023) At Indian Institute of Public Administration Under *Cyber Surakshit Bharat Initiative*



## **Executive Summary**

An professional, deep-dive training on advance concepts of CyberSecurity for Chief Information Security Officers (CISOs) was conducted for at Indian Institute of Public Administration (IIPA), New Delhi from May 8-12, 2023. This was a unique #PPP endeavor under the national *Cyber Surakshit Bharat* - funded by the National e-Government Division (#NeGD), Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (#MeitY) and 24 CISOs were painstakingly shortlisted from various public agencies/ PSUs and Defence organisations. The participants, who were all senior level government officers working as CISOs, toiled their maximum to inculcate from the experts.

In this Deep-Dive training, the participants were provided a comprehensive understanding of legal and regulatory provisions of cybersecurity including #IT Act, #IT Act amendments, #IT Rules various standards and policies such as #IEC / ISO 27001, #NIST framework, #CCMP so that when they go back after this training, they could meaningfully support their respective organizations in the development of concrete cyber crisis management strategies.

The training featured speakers from industry, academia, and government , including the in-house speaker-the Programme Coordinator itself on topics such as Governance Risk and Compliance (GRC), Landscape of Cyber Security Products in India, End Point Security, and Digital Workplace Security, Network Security, Application and Data Security, Mobile Security, Cloud Security, *Atamnirbharat* - for development of indigenous tools for cybersecurity etc. The 24 CISOs who attended this training were able to interact with the identified experts, to know the latest about Influence of New Age Technologies including BlockChain, IoTs, GenerativeAI, ChatGPT, IoTs, Quantum Computing on the changing landscape of cybersecurity as well as resolve their queries on Advanced Persistent threats (APT), Incident response mechanism (IRM), Zero Trust Architecture, forensic sciences, cybersecurity audits, risk management, Critical information infrastructure security, cryptography, SSO, Meri *Pehchaan* and many more. The skills hence inculcated were rigorously evaluated by the trained cybersecurity experts including Prof. Charru Malhotra, Mr. Dipak Singh, Prof.Ashish Agarwal and Dr.Dinesh Taneja as distinguished jury members. Collectively, all the activities and sessions had strived to provide comprehensive exposure to the ever-evolving multifaceted world of cybersecurity.

The training culminated in the valediction function that had the gracious presence of Ms. Uma Chauhan, Scientist-G, Group Coordinator (Cyber Security), MeitY as the chief guest and Mr. Dipak Singh, Senior Technical Consultant at CCA was designated as the Guest-of-Honor .
